George Williams & Joanna of Surry Co., VA, Timeline

- abt 1681 Surry Co., VA. George Williams was born to Roger Williams & Mary unknown.
 abt 1702 Surry Co., VA. George Williams, son of Roger and Mary, came of age.
 abt 1703 Surry Co., VA. George Williams married Joanna unknown.
 1704 Surry Co., VA. George Williams patented a grant of at least 200 acres, according to a deed registered 20 May 1724. [Reference?]
 16 Jun 1714 Surry Co., VA. George Williams was granted 260 acres, per deed recorded 20 Sep 1721.
- 14 Feb 1716 Surry Co., VA. George Williams, cooper, to William Lucas, Jr. ...200 acres on Cypress Swamp (a patent dated 20 Oct 1706). Wit: John Tyus and John Avary Rec: 20 Feb 1716.¹

03 May 1717 **Surry Co., VA**. John Blackborn now an inhabitant of North Carolina, to William Blackborn of Surry County...50 acres on the west side of Stoney Run and bounded by said William Blackborn, George Williams and George Jordan. Wit: Nichols Maget, Joseph Witherington, John Dullie, and Samuel Maget. John [X] Blackborn Rec:19 Mar 1717.²

- 20 Sep 1721 **Surry Co., VA**. Deed recorded: **George Williams**, a cooper, and wife, **Joanna Williams**, late of Southwarke Parish in Surry County but now of North Carolina to **Nathaniel Harrison** of Southwarke Parish for 15 pounds current money...260 acres which was granted to said Williams on 16 Jun 1714. Wit: **Benjamin Chapman Donaldson, John Mitchell** and **Burrell Green.** George Williams Joanna [X] Williams.³
- 1722 **Bertie Co., NC. George Williams** registered a cattle mark. **George Williams, Jr.,** registered a cattle mark also.⁴ These are George Williams, Jr., of Isle of Wight Co., VA, and George Williams of Surry Co., VA, son of Roger Williams.
- 04 Apr 1722 **Chowan Co., NC. Richard Milton** of Chowan Prect., Planter to **George Williams** of the Prect. afrad., Planter, 25 £ Current Money of N.C. 640 acres on the north east side of Morattoke River, joining **George Williams** and **Foreman**. Wit.: **William Maule, William Comrie**. Ack. 05 July 1722 by **Coll. William Maule** before **C. Gale**, Ch. Just. Reg. 13 July 1722.⁵ This land was then handed down and sold by his son Richard: 18 May 1740.
- 06 Apr 1722 **Chowan Precinct, NC. George Williams** 640 acres on the north side of Morattock River in Chowan Precinct, joining **Benjamin Foreman** and **Richard Milton**. Wit: **Thos. Pollock, C. Gale, Rich. Sanderson, J. Lovick, Thos Pollock Jr., John Blount**.⁶

- 13 Jul 1722 Chowan Co., NC. Thomas Busbee of Albemarle Co. and Catherine my wife to John Page of Albemarle Co. 16 £ Current Money 320 acres on the north side of Morattoke River on Jumping Run, joining James Blount and John Williams now in the actuall possession of the sd. Page part of a Pattent for 640 acres granted to me all Houses, Orchards etc. Witl: George Williams, Thomas Brown his mark Ack. 30 July 1722 before me C. Gale, Ch. Just. Reg. 22 Aug 1722.¹⁰
- 1722 Bertie Co. was formed from Chowan Co. (Both were precincts of Albemarle Co., discontinued)
- 04 Aug 1723 **Bertie Co., NC. Robert Mackrary** 400 acres in Bertie precinct on the South side of the Indian Cabbin Swamp, joining **Benjamin Foreman, George Williams, Robert Sherwood**, and the sd. swamp. Wit.: **Wm. Reed, C. Gale, R. Sanderson, J. Lovick, T. Pollock**.¹¹

- 13 Aug 1728 Bertie Co., NC. Benjamin Foreman & wife Verilah [Verity] to George Williams, 30 pds. for 600 A. on NS Roanoke River. Adj. George Williams known by name "Canoquinat." Wit: Robert Forster, Henry Turner, John Nairn, John McDaniel.¹⁴
- 14 Nov 1728 Bertie Co., NC. George Williams, Sen. to Joan (Jane) Brown (Browne) 215 A. "for good will and affection I bear to Joan, the wife of Thomas Brown…" Land on Conaquinat Swamp. Adj. Benjamin Foreman. Wit.: John Nairnr, Nov. Court 1728. Edw. Mashborne, D.C/C.¹⁵
- 05 Oct 1735 **Bertie Co., NC. George Williams, Jr.,** [not to be confused with his father's estate papers of 13 Feb 1738] made his will. Proved in Nov Court 1735, Chowan Co., NC.¹⁶
- 13 Feb 1738 Bertie Co., NC. George Williams's [Sr.] will was proved. Jurats. Jno. Page, Thos. Page, Rd. Williams & Thos. Williams Exrs. Qullafyed.rd. 40/. Richard Williams and Thomas Williams orphans of Geo. Williams Deced. produced a Rezignation (?) from Joanna Williams Relict widow of the sd. Deced. of her Right of Admin to ye sd. st.? of her to them whereupon Admin is Grantd. them Joyntly on the sd. Estate they giving Secty in the sum of £3000.¹⁷
- 15 Aug 1739 Bertie Co., NC. George Williams's [Sr.] inventory by Richard Williams and Thomas Williams. On 8 Nov 1739, his estate was divided among his (unnamed) widow who received negro Sara; Thomas Williams, Roger Williams, and Mary Harrell who received (among the three of them) negroes Buckiah and Jacob; Richard Williams, Eliza Williams and Jean Brown, who received (between the three of them) Mingo and Will. Division overseen by John Harrell, Thomas Hart and John Hart.
- 18 May 1740 Chowan Co., NC. Richard Williams, [son of George Williams], planter to Jean Brown formerly wife of Thos. Brown, dec. & to her son Arthur Brown. Wit: Jno Wynns, J. Holbrook, 200 acres part of 640 ac. which George Williams bought of Richard Melton.¹⁸
- 12 Jan 1747/8 Bertie Co., NC. Will of Joanna Williams. Probated July Court 1756. Sons and Executors: Richard and Thomas Williams. Daughter: Eliza Smith. Grandchildren: Simon Williams, Arthur Brown (negro boy to each), Mary Smith, Penelope Williams, Mary Harrell (negro to each). Witnesses: John Harrell, Easthr Chittam. Clerk of the Court: Benjamin Wynns.¹⁹
