Meadow Swamp seems to be what is now called Cohoon Swamp, several miles south of Cypress Creek. An interesting connection: I can find no patent to Richard Webb, but there is a later deed by John Askew's heir, and witnessed by Murfrey's grantee, which refers to "Richard Webb's land originally taken up by Richard Staples" bordering the Meadow Swamp. The land Richard Reynolds is selling to William Murfrey is evidently quite near this land, or perhaps part of it. That raises the question of whether there was some relationship between Richard Staples and George Williams. [NOTE: There may have been more than one George Williams of similar ages.]
